We are looking forward to your visit as always and wanted to provide you with a list of questions that the Northside Business Leaders' Political Action Committee will be asking:

- 1. What action has the City taken with reference to the imminent traffic problem created by the Mitsui OSK Lines (MOL) Project? Present assessments are 71-75% routing will be trucks and will leave going north on SR 9A and west on I-295 to either CSX & NS SIS Terminals, near Pritchard Rd. A small portion will go to the FEC Terminal near JTB and Philips Highway.**
- 2. When does the work begin on the Heckscher Dr. and SR 9A intersections and what type of fix is in the engineering plans?**
- 3. What about the railroads and possible relief they can provide?**
- 4. What will be done to relieve residential and commercial businesses on Alta Road of the major traffic issues?**
- 5. What provisions are being made for road/highway safety and increased crime?**
- 6. What provisions will be provided for road maintenance, increased trash and possible increased rodent issues?**
- 7. When will enforcement begin of 911 numbers on buildings, including City structures, commercial and residential? Original 2002-992 Ordinance provides description for displaying numbers and Ordinance 2003 provides for enforcement December 31, 2004.**
